



'Unless I had a plan to usurp him!'



'Listen, Lois. This is very important.'



I'd be on a 24/365 schedule. Playing basketball and soccer, I can score on anyone at any time. *Nobody* scores on **Superman**!









A one-man team, I'd take to the mound. Pitching was *control*. To throw the ball as close to 250 miles an hour. Faster and it could burn up.

'I love **Superman** and like all of humanity, I am grateful for his 'superassistance' in making our world a better place, a safer place. 'But enough!





'Man, and Woman must decide humanity's destiny!


Not Superman!'

'Your Majesty.'


"Have I done well?"



Billions of miles away...














Ten years ago today, he appeared. In 2015, he took a new name.


Gracefully he descended...

'Just a minute, ladies and gentlemen, I think something is happening.'




