I had no other alternative, but to move back home to historic Blake Manor.




'Welcome, Zinda! I've been needing a "home secretary" for months!'

'Ah, so! Lady Blackhawk! Highheel boots in the African bush...HAWKA-A-A-A!'








'A stunt! A ploy! The "Angels of Vengeance" are marketing themselves to the masses!'

'Castro talks freedom and liberty, eloquent rhetoric and then executes more than 600 of Batistas officers!




'Castro is either incredibly naive about communism or under Communist discipline. My guess, is the former.'

With the rise of newspapers, political cartoons took aim at corruption and warned of dark times ahead.




The first comic strip appeared in 1896 and gave birth to dozens, then hundreds more appearing in thousands of newspapers read by millions.

The strip soon evolved into the comic book.




Many of the early books were comic strips "cut and pasted" together.









'Donnevetter! What chance do any of us have?




'That fool girl won't get far! Guard the **Blackhawks** carefully! We'll round up the lady!

'You're not suggesting ...?'







More heroes were quick to follow...




Horror comics were very popular!

Soon enough, another man would impact the industry!







The Nazis crushed, Germany was divided into four Allied zones. The German captial, Berlin, was in the Russian zone and divided into four sectprs—British, French, American and Soviet.



Stalin saw Berlin as a threat. In June 1948, the Russians–who wanted Berlin all for themselves–closed all highways, railroads and canals from western-occupied Germany into western-occupied Berlin.

Unless Berlin surrendered to Soviet rule, the city would starve.

The Allies united to launch a massive airlift. Aircraft were landing and taking off every 30 seconds for nearly two years, 300,000 flights in all.

On May 12, 1949, the Soviets lifted the blockade and reopened the roads, canals and railway routes into the western half of the city. The Allies continued the airlift until September, however, because they wanted to stockpile supplies in Berlin just in case the blockade was reinstated.



Stalin died in 1953, but Berlin remained the flashpoint of the Cold War. In 1960, it was heating up yet again.



World War Two was over and won. Those who used to be our merciless, blood thirty barbaric enemies had been totally crushed by the brave and bold Allied freedom-fighters.




All that was suddenly history; superheroes were now, right now!

Leading the pack were horror books!





In true comic book irony, the man who would save the superheroes was the doctor who hated them most!

Fredric Wertham, a German-American psychologist, dispised comic books with a professional passion. His controversial 1954 book claimed that comic books, 90,000,000 published every month, were a direct threat to our children!

1) THE COMIC-BOOK FORMAT IS AN INVITATION TO ILLITERACY.


8) THEY MAY TIP THE SCALES TOWARD MALADJUSTMENT OR DELINQUENCY.



Beginning in 1948, Wertham wrote and spoke widely, arguing about the detrimental effects that comics reading had on young people.




Seduction spawned a whirlwind. Congress held committee meetings. Comics books were burned. Seemingly, superheroes got the worst of it!


Not everyone agreed.



'...When reading a comic book, children and adolescents are required to engage their imagination and visualize the elements in the story that were not graphically portrayed. Moreover, when reading a comic book, youth can self-regulate the intake of information. As such, children and adolescents can spend as much time as they like reading dialogue and viewing graphic images, thus affording youth a detailed encoding of violent material.'

Overnight, most small publishers perished. Scores of writers and artists had their imaginations and employment skewered. Surely, in the midst of this mayhem, there had to be a winner,

Horror and crime comics vanishing left and right, the superheroes again stood at the top of the market.



But for how long?

In October of 1954, after a number of hearings by the Subcommittee on Juvenile Delinquency and facing a growing concern over their works, Comic Book publishers came together to form the **Comics Code Authority** and created a set of rules and guidelines that they would have to live by. And to show that the books being published did exactly this, the group created a logo that was to be printed in the top right hand corner of each book.



From now on, there would be no more...



When the smoke finally cleared, DC superheroes ruled the industry, their rivals too weak to be worth naming. In 1960, the **Justice League of America** premiered.


