Dell had the #1 Bestseller of 1961, but **\$CROOGE** was actually down 15% and heading for the Trivia Recycling Center. Blame it on Saturday morning cartoons bombarding their audience. Cartoon comics suffered severely.

THE SECOND "BIG BANG"

The precursor to **Marvel Comics** was founded in 1939 by pulp magazine publisher Martin Goodman. To capitalize on the growing popularity of superheroes, Goodman created Timely **Comics**.




In 1961 at age 40, Stanley Martin Lieber had come to a dead end. He'd been working for his uncle's company since he was seventeen. He wrote his first story in 1941 (as *Stan Lee*), then went to war (As a *writer*!).

When he came home, the business was in rut. Comics got little respect and comicbook writers got none at all. Stan wanted to quit and write the Great American Novel.

But he had a few ideas he wanted to flesh out. Stan Lee's "creative streak" can only be compared to Albert Einstein's "magical period."





Over four months, March through June 1905, Albert Einstein produced four papers that revolutionized science. One explained how to measure the size of molecules in a liquid, a second posited how to determine their movement, and a third described how light comes in packets called photons—the foundation of quantum physics and the idea that eventually won him the Nobel Prize.


A fourth paper introduced special relativity, leading physicists to reconsider notions of space and time that had sufficed since the dawn of civilization. Then, a few


months later, almost as an afterthought, Einstein pointed out in a fifth paper that matter and energy can be interchangeable at the atomic level specifically, that E=mc2, the scientific basis of nuclear energy and the most famous mathematical equation in history.

'While I was thinking, I saw a fly crawling on the wall. That would be cool! The next thing I needed was a name! "Crawl-Man? Nah, that didn't have it! Insect-Man? I ran down the list. Mosquito-Man, Beetle-Man, Fly-Man...

'Then I hit on Spider-Man!

'It somehow had a dramatic feeling, a scary feeling. That's it!'

My publisher didn't think so, but as always, my dear wife backed me!



'People hate spiders! You can't call a hero Spider-Man! Don't you understand? Teenagers can only be sidekicks!'



'Why not write it the way you want it? If it doesn't work, the worst that's going to happen is they'll fire you. And you want to quit anyway.'



Steve Ditko did the art, including the iconic costume. Jack Kirby contributed the cover. Some sixty years later, a mint *Amazing Fantasy 15* sold for \$1.2M!



'We put him on the cover and forgot about him. Then a couple of months later, the sales figures came in.
